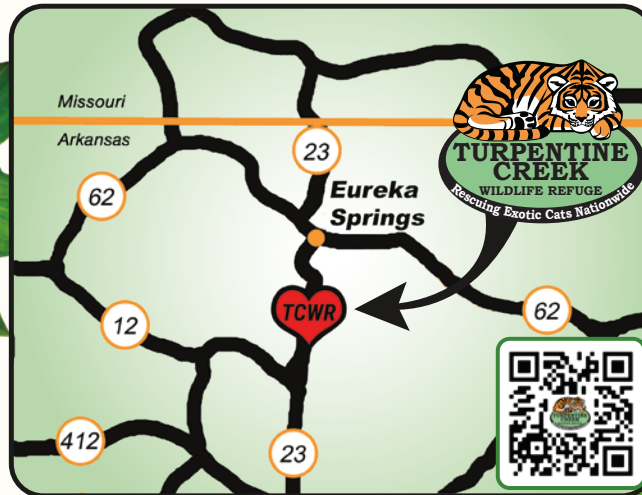

Why do big cats, bears and other survivors of the exotic animal trade need your help?

Until recently, exotic cat ownership legislation varied from state to state. Passage of the Big Cat Public Safety Act in 2022 prohibits private ownership or public handling of the big cats, yet smaller species like bobcats and servals remain unregulated at the federal level. As the Big Cat Public Safety Act is enacted, more and more animals will need to be rehomed to legitimate sanctuaries like Turpentine Creek Wildlife Refuge and the smaller species continue to be at risk of exploitation.

As a nonprofit organization, your admission, lodging fees, retail purchases and donations allow us to be a strong voice for animals who would otherwise have none. Because of your support, we can provide lifetime care to so many animals in need.
